Take care of yourself. Remember that you are loved and prayed for every night.

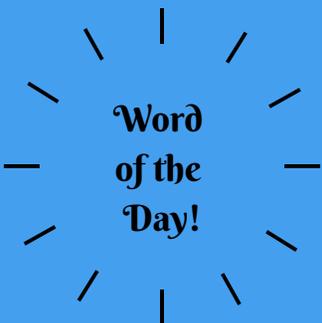


