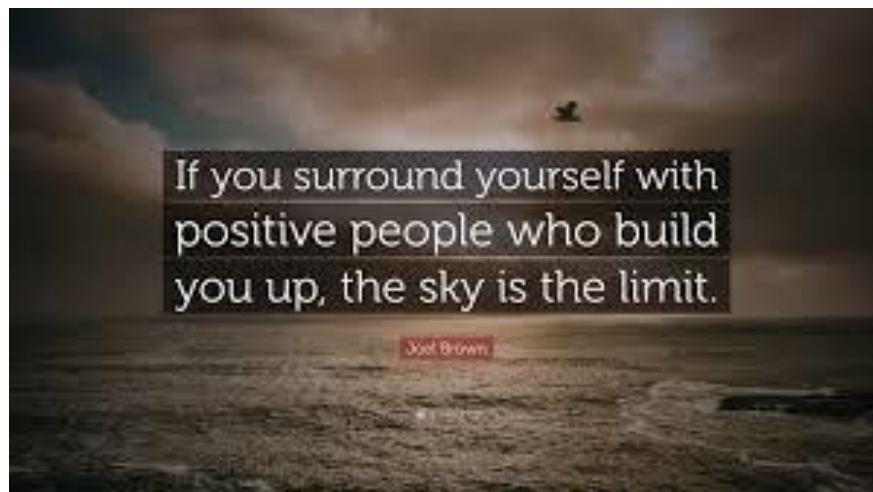

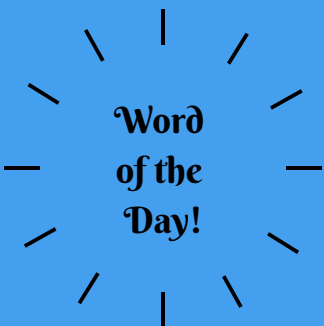

Today we're going to spend one hour learning to code. Has anyone here heard the term "code" before? What does it mean? "Code" means a set of instructions that a computer can understand. Today you are going to practice "coding," "programming" and "debugging".

- Coding means to write code, or to write instructions for a computer.
- Programming, similarly, means to write code or instructions.
- Debugging means to check code for mistakes and try to fix errors.
